**WATER BOTTLES:** Can I remind all parents that water bottles should only be filled with water. No juice required! Thank you.


**RECEPTION PLACES:** Parents have now been informed that their child has been allocated a place in Reception. We have 1 space in Reception for September 2021.... Spread the word!
