NSPCC ASSEMBLIES: On Wednesday we had visitors from the NSPCC to deliver assemblies about their Speak Out. Stay Safe. programme. The NSPCC's work in schools will help encourage conversations about staying safe – and they have a number of child-friendly materials to help you carry on the conversation afterwards. That includes 'The Underwear Rule', a simple way for parents to help keep children safe from abuse. The guide uses the rules of PANTS to teach children that their body belongs to them and them alone.
