Maths – As a mathematician we will learn.....

- Recite numbers in order and back to 10, 20 and 30.
- Recognising numbers 10 and 20.
- Writing numbers to 10.
- Counting objects to 10 and 20.
- 2D shape.
- 1 more, 1 less to 10.
- Use positional language.
- Create repeating patterns.



In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will....

- Make new friends.
- Adapt to changes in the new school environment and the new people who help us,
- The values of friendship, forgiveness and honesty.
- Christian festivals such as Harvest and Christmas.
- Exploring festivals from other religions, such as Diwali.



In Physical Development we will learn.....

- A variety of multi-skills – throwing, catching, using a bat, moving in different ways.
- Gymnastics – different types of rolls, using equipment to jump and land safely.
